


- Sental Health First Aid Act (S. 153/H.R. 274)
 - Introduced in the House by Congressman Ron Barber (D-AZ) and in the Senate by Senators Mark Begich (D-AK) and Kelly Ayotte (R-NH) with nine bipartisan cosponsors.
- \$15 million in SAMHSA funding for Mental Health First Aid in schools
- State Policy Toolkit
 - Available at <u>www.mentalhealthfirstaid.org/cs/about/legislation-policy</u>
- 30 bills introduced in 21 states
- 15 States with Legislative Action or Appropriations
 - Arizona, Colorado, Connecticut, Illinois, Indiana, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Nebraska, New York, Oklahoma, Texas, Virginia, Washington, California
