Coordinated Entry in the Balance of State CoC




Background Info on BoS Continuum

- □ 152 counties excluding major metropolitan cities in Georgia
- □ First submitted in 1998 nearly \$4 million dollars awarded
- □ Currently approximately \$15.5 million

Uniqueness of Balance of State CoC

- □ 152 county region
 - Mostly rural
 - Some pockets include communities outside major metro areas
- □ Limited homeless resources in many areas, particularly shelters
- Existing resources in a given area may be limited to certain subpopulations
- □ Significant variation in economy, housing market, employment opportunities, referral processes

Responses to Unique Challenges-CE

- □ Need for "no wrong door" approach
- □ System must be virtual/accessible from anywhere
- □ Keep it in HMIS as much as possible
- Need for increased partnerships with non-homeless housing providers
- Respect regional differences and allow some discretion in referral process

Efforts So Far

- □ Planning began in summer 2015
- □ Receiving HUD TA
- Committee and subcommittee structure
 - □ Access public access to system
 - □ Assess common assessment and pre-screen
 - □ Assign referrals for housing/services
- □ Developing web portal for DCA housing resources
- Adopted a common assessment tool
 - Barriers to Housing Stability vs. VISPDAT

Future Planning Efforts

- Research on Barriers to Housing Stability Assessments (BHSA)
 - By project type
 - □ Connect barriers to outcomes
 - □ Revision of BHSA to prioritize
- Adopt regional planning model
- Do research/hold listening sessions in regions
- □ Partnering for call center- 800 # for public access
- Develop API for interaction with HMIS
