

# Georgia Housing Voucher Program

- Program Design

- A “Housing First” approach
- Voluntary flexible community based services
- Access to community activities based on the individual's preference
- Lease in individual's name
- Fair Market Rent standard with a utility allowance
- 30 to 40% of individual's income towards housing cost
- Unit must meet Housing Quality Standards (HQS)
- Housing separate from service compliance
